The Africa NDC Hub is committed to supporting African countries in effectively implementing the UNFCCC Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF).

Building on from the successful 2-days seminar on **Africa's ETF readiness** at the sidelines of the Africa Climate Summit (ACS) in Nairobi, this event aims to create the opportunity for countries to share their experience in implementing MRV and ETF, engage with stakeholders, discuss support activities, and explore potential collaboration opportunities to strengthen transparency efforts in the region.
